

Comfort & Care



Hospice of Humboldt (HOH) is an independent non-profit that provides heartfelt end-of-life care, palliative care, and grief support services. HOH has been caring for people with life-threatening and life-limiting illnesses since 1979.

HOH services include:

- Hospice Care A plan of care to create a comfortable, dignified, and peaceful end of life at home.
- Palliative Care A plan of care to provide relief of symptoms / stress from a life-limiting illness, even if receiving curative treatment.
- Grief Support Services Providing individual and group support for those processing the death or dying of a loved one.
- Ida Emmerson Hospice House Inpatient facility providing acute and residential care for those who cannot remain at home.

We focus on quality of life for both patients and their loved ones, with an emphasis on pain control and symptom management. All care is under the direction of our physician in coordination with the patient's primary care provider. All diagnoses and ages are eligible for care.

Hospice Care

Hospice care is available at home, in nursing homes, or residential care facilities — even for those living alone. A patient doesn't need to be homebound to receive hospice care. Hospice services are covered by Medicare, Medi-Cal, and most private insurance plans. No one is turned away due to inability to pay.

When home is no longer an ideal place for our hospice patients, there is another option. Our inpatient facility provides a homelike environment and around-the-clock specialized care.

Patients who have symptoms that cannot be managed at home or whose caregivers need a break can stay at the Hospice House for a few days at a time, and those who wish to make the Hospice House their home may do so for as long as they want. Home-Based Palliative Care

Palliative care gives relief from the symptoms and stress that arise when someone is coping with a serious illness. Palliative care is available even if a person is still receiving curative treatment; it is not necessary to give up current doctors.

We offer an extra layer of support for individuals and families by providing in-home support that allows people to live fully and comfortably.

Grief Support Services

The complex and painful issues involved with death, dying, and the grieving process touch the lives of many, not just patients and their families. Grief support is offered on an individual basis and in support groups.

Services are given to:

- Any community member who is trying to deal with the death of a loved one from any disease or cause.
- Anyone seeking information or services about how to cope with an actual or impending death of a loved one.
